

Dining information around Kyoto University

There are three restaurants within the campus around the clock tower: French Restaurant La Tour (>1500 JPY for lunch) Café Restaurant Camphore (500-1000 JPY for lunch) University Cafeteria (~500 JPY for lunch, many foods for students' casual dinning)

There are many restaurants and cafes around the campus, especially around the Hyakumanben intersection. If you try a fine Japanese food, the organizers recommendation is "Takuma (琢磨)" (Japanese Kaiseki) at the north-west corner of Hyakumanben, and "Ginka (銀華)" (Soba noodle), 50m on a small street into north-west direction from Hyakumanben.

In the university shop in the underground floor of the clock tower, or the convenience stores like "Lawson" and "Family Mart", you can buy drinks, food (bento lunch box, onigiri, sandwiches, snacks etc.), and daily necessaries.

A tip for vegetarians: There is a famous vegetarian, traditional formal Japanese Kaiseki restaurant "Nakahigashi" on the Imadegawa street, about 15 min walk from Hyakumanben. The price is 10000-15000 JPY for dinner. Ask your Japanese colleague for reservation, if you are interested.
